Some prints from thermal printers look bad.

In RIP and Print, choose angled screen as dither type in the advanced tab. Click the screen button to the right. Adjust line frequency to achieve satisfactory results. (We recommend that you leave shape and angle settings to default.)

Change the line frequency for each color channel.

- For 600 dpi printers, set frequency to 110 lines per inch.
- For 300 dpi printers, set frequency to 55 lines per inch.

Keep the angle setting the same.
