



Installing the Software and Viewing the User's Manuals

Acrobat Reader is required to display the user's manuals.

If Acrobat Reader is not installed on the computer you're using, then when you click "Read User's Manual" for the first time, the program for installing and setting up Acrobat Reader starts. Follow the on-screen instructions to proceed with installation and setup.


If you are installing under Windows NT 4.0/2000/XP, log on to Windows as a member of the "Administrators" or "Power Users" group. For more information about groups, refer to the documentation for Windows.

For Windows

- 1. Switch on the computer and start Windows.
- 2. Place the CD-ROM from the Roland Software Package in the CD-ROM drive. The Setup menu appears automatically.
- 3. When the screen appears, click the drop-down arrow for [Click here] and choose the name of the model you're using.



For the CX-24, choose [CX-24]. For the CX-12, choose [CX-12]. The screen at right appears.



Installing the Software

Before installing, click [Readme] for the software and read the information displayed.

This software is required when sending data from a Windows-based program to the CX-24/ 12. If you're using Windows, be sure to install this driver.



Installation of the driver starts.

When the screen for selecting the port appears, choose the port where the computer is

When installation finishes, the driver settings are displayed.

Dr. STIKA PLUS

This is a Windows-based program for making stickers by using TrueType fonts installed in Windows. It creates the cutting data for the CX-24/12.



The setup menu of Dr. STIKA PLUS appears.






Quick Guide


Installing Blade






Loading the Material

Pass the material through the unit and place it on the grit rollers.



Positions of the grit rollers CX-24




Positions of the grit rollers CX-12



Line up the left and right edges of the material with either of the corresponding grit rollers.


Reduce the amount of slant of the material.



2–3 Move the pinch rollers over the grit rollers.

Check the position of the grit rollers, using the white sticker on the rail portion as a guide.


Pinch roller



Move the pinch rollers over the grit rollers.


2–4 Secure the material in place.

Raise the sheet loading lever. This lowers the pinch rollers to hold the material in place.

Press the [ENTER] key.

When you press the [ENTER] key, the tool carriage moves to the left

When you are using the CX-24/12 for the first time, when setup is complete, the origin point is automatically set at the following location.

: Near the left pinch roller

: Near the left pinch roller On the CX-24/12, you can freely set the origin point at any location in

If you want to set the origin point at a location other than the foregoing,

: At the front lower left of the material

Pressing the [TEST] key cuts the pattern shown in the figure below at the present position of the tool.

Peel off the material and check the cutting quality.

If the material does not peel off as shown in the figure below, take a look at "CX-24/12 User's Manual - 4-7 Cutting Test" on the CD-ROM and adjust the cutting conditions.

Peel this off next. The blade should leave faint traces on the base paper of the material.



Peel this off first. The square should remain, without peeling off.



Performing Cutting

When you have finished making the preparations in steps 1 through 4, send cutting commands from the program you're using. Cutting starts on the CX-24/12.
