Cut setup for Corel Draw 8, 9, 10, 11

COREL 11

In CorelDraw follow these steps:

1. Go to TOOLS menu
2. Go to Color Management
3. Change Style to *COLOR MANAGEMENT OFF*, this will de-activate color calibration.
1. When creating objects assign a "Hairline" width to object.

In Print Preview

1. Place the object in the top left hand corner.
2. Press Print

NOTE: In some instances, text or graphics needs to be converted to curves.

COREL 10

In CorelDraw follow these steps:

1. Go to TOOLS menu
2. Go to Color Management
3. Change Style to *COLOR MANAGEMENT OFF*, this will de-activate color calibration.
1. When creating objects assign a "Hairline" width to object.

In Print Preview

1. Place the object in the top left hand corner.
2. Press Print

COREL 9

In CorelDraw follow these steps:

1. Go to TOOLS menu
2. Go to OPTIONS
3. In Options Menu go to Global
4. Highlight Color Management
5. De-active the CALLIBRATE COLOR FOR DISPLAY
6. Click OK
1. When creating objects, assign a .001 outline to the object you want to cut (From the Outline Dialogue Box).

In Print Preview

1. Place the object in the top left hand corner.
2. Press Print

COREL 8

In CorelDraw follow these steps:

1. Go to TOOLS menu
2. Go to OPTIONS

3. In Options Menu go to Global
4. Highlight Color Management
5. De-active the CALLIBRATE COLOR FOR DISPLAY
6. Click OK

1. When creating objects assign a .001 outline to the object you want to cut.

In Print Preview

1. Place the object in the top left hand corner.
2. Press Print

Communication connection

Make sure the printer selected is a Roland printer and verify the output port.

Serial port -(*Recommended*) Use only Roland serial cable and make sure port settings are *Bits per second* - 9600, *Data*

bit -8, *Parity* - none, *Flow control* - Hardware.

Parallel port - establish direct connection to the device via 6Ft. cable. Do not use printer switch box or pass through any

other device. Make sure the LPT print mode setting is *SPP* or *Output* only.

For earlier versions of Corel Draw we do not have any recommended settings. Please upgrade your Software to Corel Draw 8,9,10.
