


Subject: Off-center rings or incomplete rings

The following document discusses possible issues that may occur with pieces coming out of the JWX-30 shifted or not being completely cut out.

When you have a ring in JewelStudio or other design software and you have started the importation to SRP Player, there will be a window that pops up asking what type of clamp to use. Please make sure the "Set origin to center of model" is NOT checked off.


Subject: Off-center rings or incomplete rings



If it is checked off, then the ring will not be centered and cause the ring to be cut off-center on the flat


side and the rotary side. Notice the ring is off center from the origin position in the below windows.

The origin symbol should be in the center of the ring, not off to the side.





Please make sure the below box is not checked off when importing into SRP Player.
